The cost is \$92. The jackets are produced by Kooga Clothing; they are waterproof, windproof and very warm. This is the only item of clothing with a hood that may be worn to school.

# YEAR 13

These students are not required to wear school uniform, but must be in clean and appropriate clothing including footwear at all times. Hoodies are not permitted.

## **OPTIONAL EXTRAS FOR ALL STUDENTS**

School scarf (available at The Warehouse), or option of plain dark green or black scarf. Students are permitted to wear a single dark coloured jacket at school. Must be rainproof, not leather and puffa jackets are allowed.

White or black short sleeved under tops may be worn under uniform shirts.

Long hair must be tied back when students are in workshops. Boys are to be clean shaven. JEWELLERY / FACIAL PIERCING: Maximum of one piercing in each ear.
