The School Day

The teaching programme begins at 8.40am each morning (except Fridays for Years 10-13 students beginning at 10am) and the end of day is 3pm.

Lunch Times

No students are permitted to leave the schools grounds without note from their parent/caregiver. The shop in Morris Spence Avenue is out of bounds to all students during school time.

Canteen

GENERAL SCHOOL FEE \$90.00

The General School Fee is a voluntary, tax-deductible donation. Income from this helps us provide such things as, our extensive curriculum learning extension programmes and in-class support. Without your support we will have to limit both. An example of this support is to partly cover the overhead costs of maintaining and upgrading the computers, printers and associated equipment. \$20 goes separately towards actual printing costs which are charged from the user accounts.

SPORT FEE \$50.00

The **Sport Fee** allows us to make available a large number of sports for all our students. This is a compulsory fee if you play organised sport, and covers affiliation fees, uniforms, venue hireage. The fee covers the student if they play one or more sports.

SUBJECT FEES:

- There is a subject fee attached to some subjects for Years 9 - 13 students. These will be itemised on your first school fee account and are for take home related costs ie: food technology, projects, art projects.

NZQA Costs. If students are in Year 11, 12 or 13 they will be entered in the National Certificate of Education Achievement (NCEA). There are costs that need to be paid to the New Zealand Qualification Authority (NZQA) who advise that a full year course will cost \$76.70. The school collects these fees for NZQA and they need to be paid before the end of August.

NZQA Financial Support: If the main caregiver of a Year 11-13 student is receiving a WINZ benefit or hold a Community Services Card their payment can be reduced to \$20. If more than two children in a family are studying for NCEA and they qualify for Financial Assistance the fee is reduced to \$30 per family which will appear on the account as \$15 each child. **Application for this support must be made before the end of the second term and the form can be obtained from the Student Office.**
