- Have realistic goals and expectations for the next five years.
- Be able to articulate these goals and be aware of the strategies they may need to use to achieve them.
- Maintain a high level of attendance
- Consistently give their best and demonstrate school values
- Be able to provide evidence of this achievement. Evidence of achievement will include:

**Academic** - Evidence of achievement in Nationally Norm Referenced Assessments, from your current school. These include PAT's, asTTle, STAR.

**Arts/Culture** – Evidence of achievement may include (though not limited to) School reports, References, Music certificates, Dance certificates, Involvement in Theatre, Competing in Kapa Haka.

**Sport** – Evidence of achievement in either individual or team sports.

The scholarship is worth \$1000 (includes a chromebook and chromebook case, the remainder of the scholarship money is placed in the student's school account, available to use for school related costs.

Students who are awarded a scholarship need to show responsibility in their field ie academic, arts/culture, sport that their scholarship has been awarded for. Example of this would be: Sports: expectation to participate in sports teams, house competitions, athletics day, Cultural: involved with cultural events and activities, Academic: having an ongoing commitment to academic excellence, and overall scholarship students would need to have a commitment to their individual success.
